Information for Parents/Guardians

Students will receive Driver Education instruction for a minimum of 30 hours in a classroom and 6 hours in a car behind the wheel. The vehicle used has a dual-brake control and is insured for all who ride in it. The 6 hours of in-car instruction provides a very basic level of driver training. It is extremely important, therefore, that the student be allowed to practise in the family vehicle until he/she has mastered what has been taught. It is in this area that parents/guardians have an integral part to play in the satisfactory completion of the training.

Successful program students will hold a learner's license. All students under the age of 16 with a learner's license must be accompanied by the parent, legal guardian or authorized instructor who holds a current valid operator's license. Anyone accompanying a student driver must fulfil the requirements as outlined in the SGI Driver Handbook.

High School Driver Education

SGI Customer Number and Online Testing

Beginning **January, 2015** you must have a SGI customer number to enrol in high school driver education. This can be done well in advance - the sooner the better!

Visit a motor licence issuer to:

Get yourself a customer number

- Bring two pieces of original identification to establish your full legal name, complete date of birth and signature (e.g., Canadian birth certificate/Canadian passport and Saskatchewan health card). Visit www.sgi.sk.ca for more information.
- Once your identification is established, you will receive a Personal Identification Document containing your customer number. Verify this for accuracy and ensure all information including: height, gender and eye colour are accurate
- Present your identification document to your high school driving instructor. Note: If you currently have an SGI non-driver photo ID, your customer number is indicated on the photo card.

Register a valid email address (only required for online testing)

Note: if you currently have a SGI non-driver photo ID, you can register an email address by calling the SGI Customer Service Centre in Regina (306) 775-6900 or toll free 1-800-667-9868

Online versus paper testing

Many schools offer online testing for your Class 7 learners knowledge exam as an alternative to paper testing. Features of online testing include:

- colourful graphics to clarify the meaning of questions
- immediate feedback tells you if you're right or wrong
- instant scoring confirms whether you passed or failed

After you register an email address you can now create a MySGI account and write your tests online during the high school program.

Register for MySGI

- Make sure you have added an email address to your customer profile. An activation code will automatically be sent to your email account. You will use this code to set up your MySGI account
- Register for a secure online account by going to www.sgi.sk.ca/online* and select the **Register** button
- Select *I have an activation code*
- Select **Submit**
- Enter your customer number and your activation code, then select the **Submit** button
- Create a username and password and submit
- Review and accept the Terms of Use **
